I am writing to let you know that the Division of Historical Resources (DHR) has reviewed the inventory form prepared for the Pelham Library and Memorial Building and has determined that it is eligible for listing on both the New Hampshire State Register and the National Registers of Historic Places.

To officially list the building on the New Hampshire State Register, please have the Town Council check and sign this letter below and return it to our office at the address noted above. If so, at its quarterly meeting on 28 July 2008, the State Historical Resources Council (SHRC) will review the inventory form and make the final decision as to listing.
